

## *Abandoned Oil and Gas Wells*



# **Are You at Risk?**

*Altering or tampering with oil and gas wells may cause personal injury, environmental damage and/or financial liability. Locating and plugging these wells in the future becomes much more difficult.*

**Personal injury** and/or death can result from encountering

- unknown pressures,
- flammable liquids,
- explosive gases, and
- toxic gases.

**Environmental damage** can result from oil, gas, and brine contamination of

- surface and subsurface soil,
- springs, streams, rivers and lakes; and
- water wells.

**Financial liability**, costing hundreds to thousands of dollars, can include

- property damage,
- medical costs,
- environmental damage and cleanup costs,
- loss of wildlife, livestock and pets,
- plugging costs, and
- legal fees and fines.

## **Ohio Orphan Well Program**

Landowners can refer oil and gas wells to the ODNR Orphan Well Program for proper plugging. These wells are prioritized according to severity and/or threat of hazard to public health and safety.

Local inspectors need to document each well, record the location and inspect it for leaking oil and gas. The Division regulates all oil and gas drilling and production activities in Ohio including permitting, well drilling, production and well plugging.
