## METAL & GLASS



### RECYCLE:

- all metals
- glass jars
- glass bottles

Empty aerosol containers, discard lids & rinse containers.

**NOT ACCEPTED**  
lightbulbs  
flower vases  
drinking glasses  
window glass



## PAPER & CARDBOARD



### RECYCLE:

- newspapers
- cereal boxes
- magazines
- office paper
- phone books
- cardboard
- junk mail



**NOT ACCEPTED**  
paper towels  
pet food bags  
wax-coated boxes  
foil wrapping paper



## YARD WASTE & COMPOSTING



Keep yard waste out of landfills. Call your local waste hauler to check on pick up schedules.

**NOT ACCEPTED**  
pet waste,  
stumps, branches  
more than 4"  
thick or 36" long,  
plastic flower pots

Composting can dramatically reduce the volume of material a household sends to a landfill.



## PLASTICS



**Look for the number** on the bottom of the container. Most recyclers accept #1 and #2 plastics - check with your local Solid Waste District to learn more.

Discard lids & rinse containers.

## DISPOSAL OF ELECTRONICS



Electronic devices contain toxic chemicals. Take them to a recycling service where they can be reused or broken down into reusable parts.
