Largemouth Bass

OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT

Largemouth bass were sampled by electrofishing during spring 2006. More than 66% of the bass sampled were 12" and greater. Thirty-two percent of these fish were also 15" and longer. About 5% of the fish were at least 20"!

Crappie

OUTLOOK: FAIR

Both white and black crappie were sampled during fall 2006 trap-netting surveys, although twice as many black crappie were captured. More than 77% of black crappie sampled measured 8" and more, with 34% of the fish reaching 10" and longer. NOTE: There will be a 9" length limit and daily bag limit of 30 crappie at this lake in 2010.

Channel Catfish

OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT

Yearling channel catfish are stocked in odd-numbered years. Catfish stocked in 2007 should easily be 18" by 2010.

Sunfish

OUTLOOK: GOOD

Bluegill were sampled by electrofishing during spring 2006. Twenty-three percent of the bluegill sampled measured at least 6".

NOTES:

Long Lake is the last lake in the Portage Lakes chain. As with North Reservoir, it is not possible to boat between this and other lakes within the chain.
