Largemouth Bass

OUTLOOK: FAIR

A spring day-time electrofishing survey was conducted during 2006 at this small lake. Sixty percent of the bass sampled were 12"+. Even though bass densities are not high, there are some opportunities to catch some quality-sized fish.

Channel Catfish

OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT

Yearling channel catfish are stocked during odd-numbered years.

Sunfish

OUTLOOK: GOOD

Bluegill were also sampled in relatively small numbers during the spring 2006 electrofishing surveys. More than 55% of the bluegill sampled measured at least 6".

Rainbow Trout

OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT

Rainbow trout (10" to 14") are stocked each year in mid-October to provide fall fishing opportunities. Opportunities are best for the first three weeks following the stocking.
