Largemouth Bass

OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT

Largemouth bass were sampled by electrofishing during spring 2005. Most bass sampled were 12" and greater. Twenty-four percent of these fish were also 15" and longer.

Crappie

OUTLOOK: GOOD

White crappie were sampled during fall 2009 trap-netting surveys. Nearly 31% of the fish sampled were at least 8", with a small percentage of crappie also reaching 10" and longer.

Channel Catfish

OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT

Yearling channel catfish are stocked in even-numbered years. Harvested channel catfish averaged more than 15", based on 2004 creel survey results.

Sunfish

OUTLOOK: POOR

Bluegill were sampled by electrofishing during spring 2004. A very small number of fish measured at least 6". Harvested bluegill averaged 6.5", based on 2004 creel survey results.

NOTES:

Wheelchair accessible shoreline fishing facilities are available. Spencer Lake is owned by the Division of Wildlife and is part of the Spencer Wildlife Area.
