Largemouth Bass

OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT

Largemouth bass were sampled by electrofishing during spring 2009. Fifty-eight percent of the bass sampled were 12" and greater. Five percent of these fish were also 15" and longer.

Channel Catfish

OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT

Yearling channel catfish are stocked during even-numbered years.

Sunfish

OUTLOOK: POOR

Bluegill were sampled by electrofishing during spring 2009. None of the small number of bluegill sampled measured even 6".

Rainbow Trout

OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT

Rainbow trout (10"-14") are stocked each spring by the Division of Wildlife. Fishing opportunities are best following the stockings, but usually continue for another two to three weeks.

NOTES:

Wheelchair accessible shoreline fishing facilities are available. Silver Creek Lake is owned by Metroparks Serving Summit County (330-867-5511). The fisheries resources are managed by the Division of Wildlife through an agreement with Metroparks Serving Summit County.
