Largemouth Bass

OUTLOOK: GOOD

Largemouth bass were sampled by electrofishing during spring 2007. Nearly 31% of the bass sampled were 12" and greater. Four percent of these fish were also 15" and longer.

Channel Catfish

OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT

Yearling channel catfish are stocked in even-numbered years.

Sunfish

OUTLOOK: GOOD

Bluegill were sampled by electrofishing during spring 2007. Twenty-eight percent of the fish sampled measured 6", with none of them reaching 8".
