Wellington Upground Reservoir is owned by the Village of Wellington (440-647-4626). The Division of Wildlife manages this reservoir through an agreement with the Village of Wellington. The Division of Wildlife has stocked various fish species including walleye, smallmouth bass, yellow perch, and channel catfish at this reservoir through 1990. Unfortunately, upground reservoirs are very difficult to sample and we have no current information on population levels. There are walleye, largemouth bass, smallmouth bass, white crappie, channel catfish, bullhead, and bluegill in this reservoir.
