Largemouth Bass **OUTLOOK: GOOD**

In a survey conducted in 2005, 19% of the largemouth bass sampled were 12-inches or larger, while 14% of the bass were 15-inches or larger.

Bluegill **OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT**

Sunfish are abundant at Lake Alma. Both bluegill and redear sunfish can be found with bluegill being the predominate species. The 2005 survey showed 33% of the bluegill were 6-inches or larger. Considering redear sunfish, 13% of fish sampled were 6-inches or larger, while 5% were 8-inches or larger.

Channel Catfish **OUTLOOK: UNKNOWN**

Channel catfish are stocked in alternate years at Lake Alma. The channel catfish population has not been investigated.

Trout **OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT**

Catchable size rainbow trout are stocked each year in the fall to provide another highly desirable sport fish opportunity.

NOTES:

Lake Alma is located at Lake Alma State Park, off of SR 349, 1 mile NE of Wellston, Ohio. High densities of aquatic vegetation limits angling pressure and success by mid to late summer.
