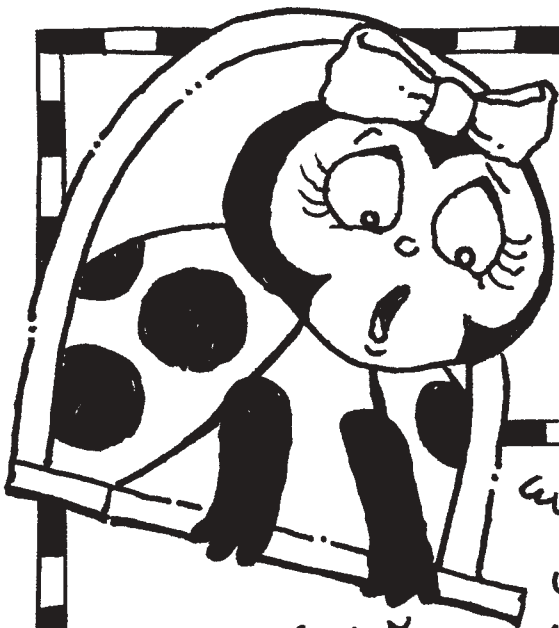

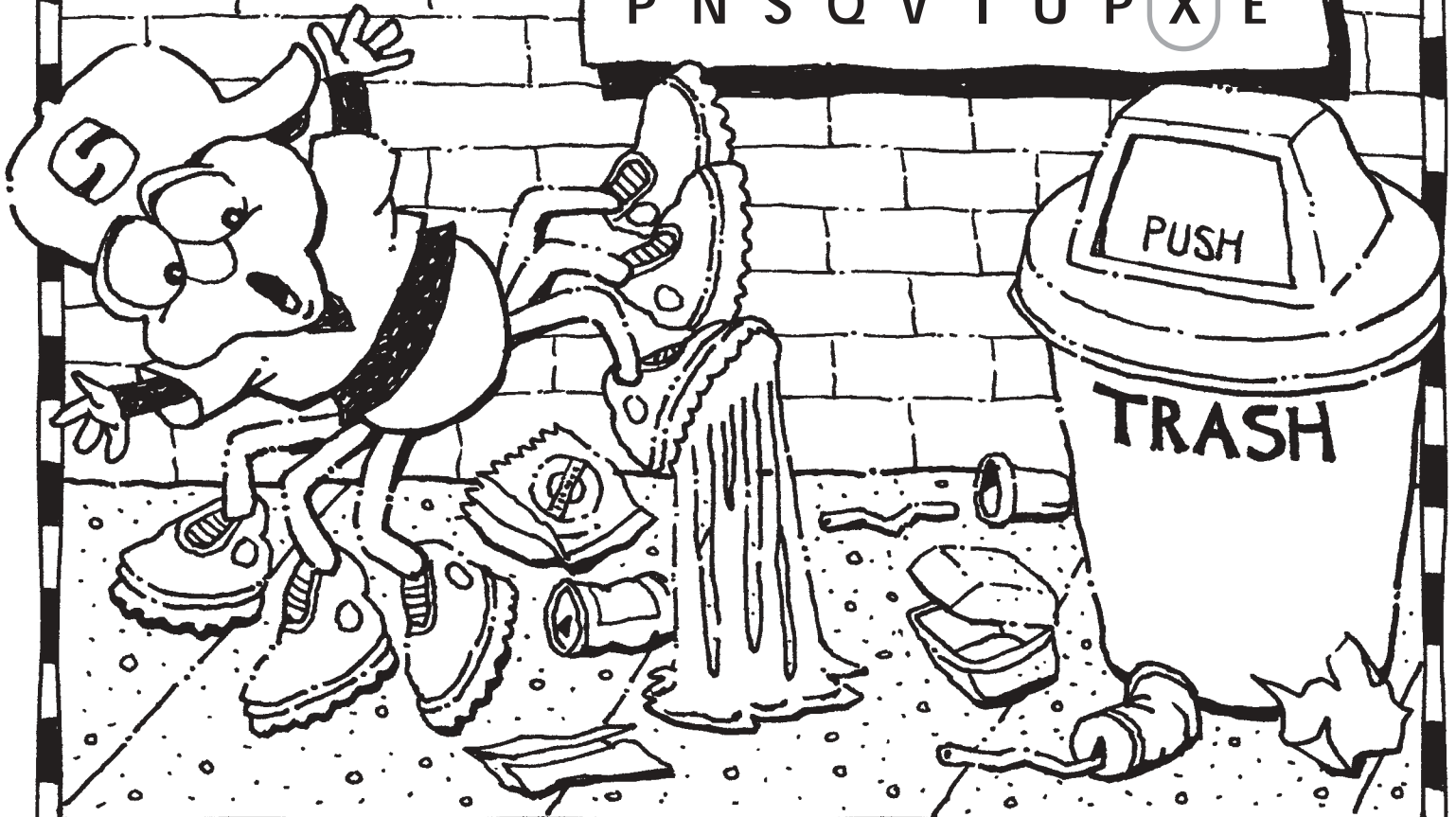

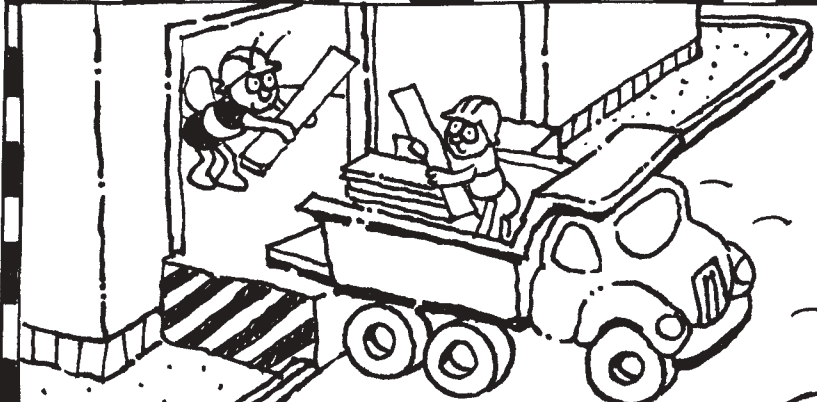
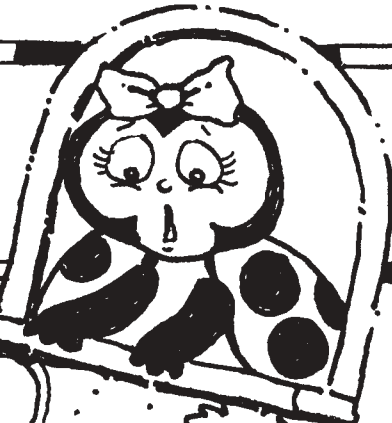
Help Lucky clean up Bugville. In the puzzle above, find the hidden words of things that can be recycled or thrown away.

Lumber falls off truck - Try again



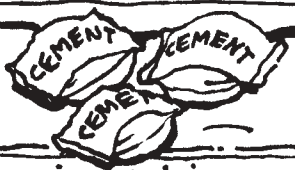
Nails fall off truck - Try again

Cement bags fall off truck - Try again



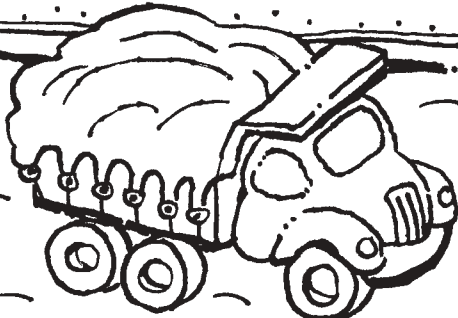
Wire falls off truck - Try again



Shingles fall off truck - Try again

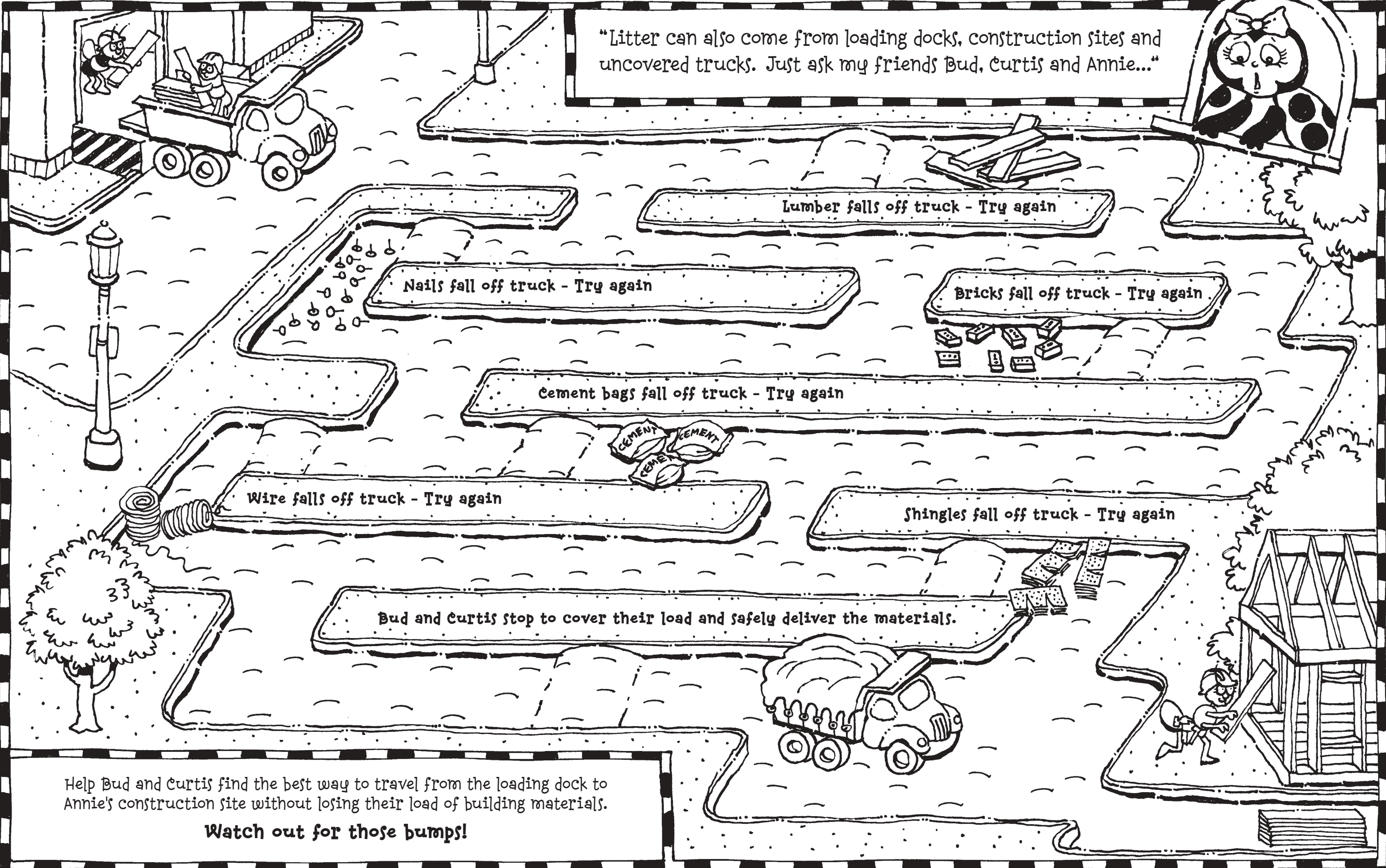


Bud and Curtis stop to cover their load and safely deliver the materials.

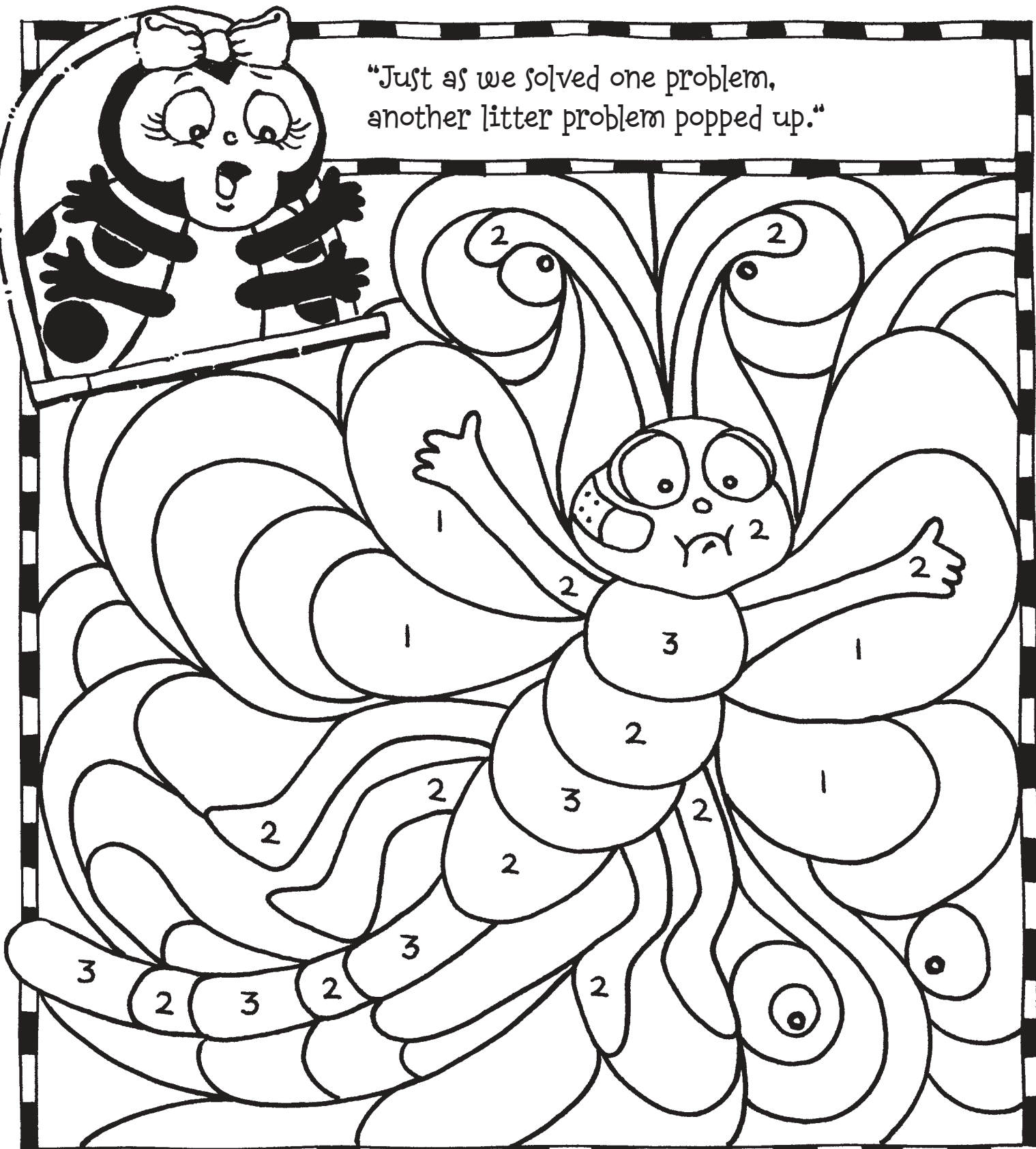


Help Bud and Curtis find the best way to travel from the loading dock to Annie's construction site without losing their load of building materials.

another litter problem popped up."




Which one of Lucky's friends has been hurt by litter? Using the color code,

1 = Yellow

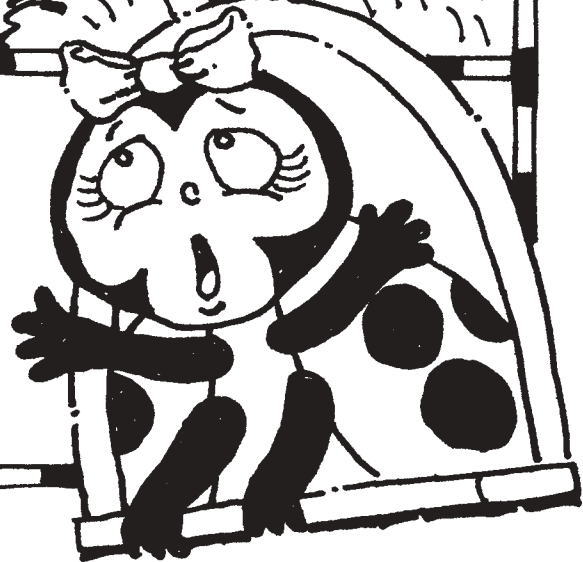
2 = Green

Thanks for helping my friends and I turn Litterville back into Bugville!"

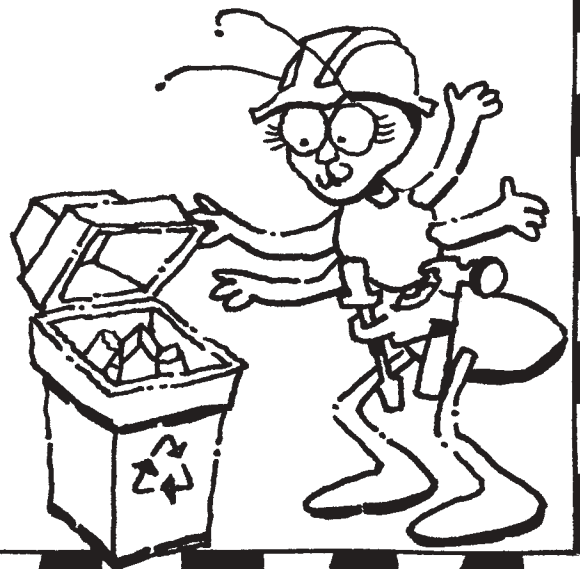
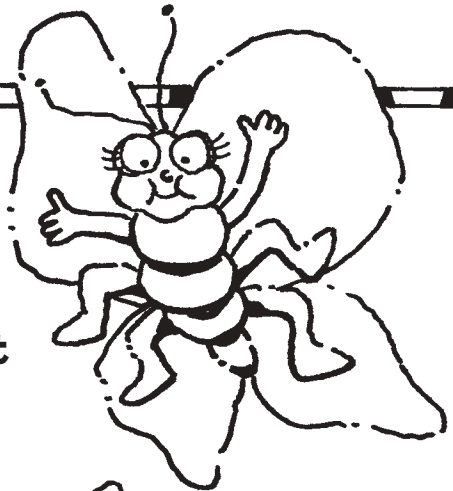
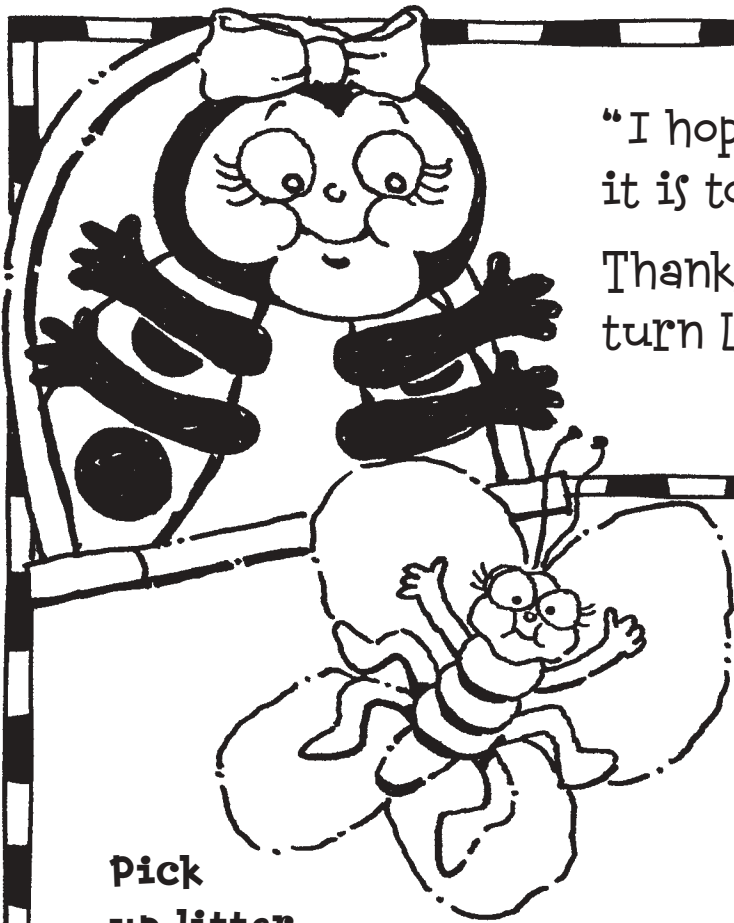
Don't litter!

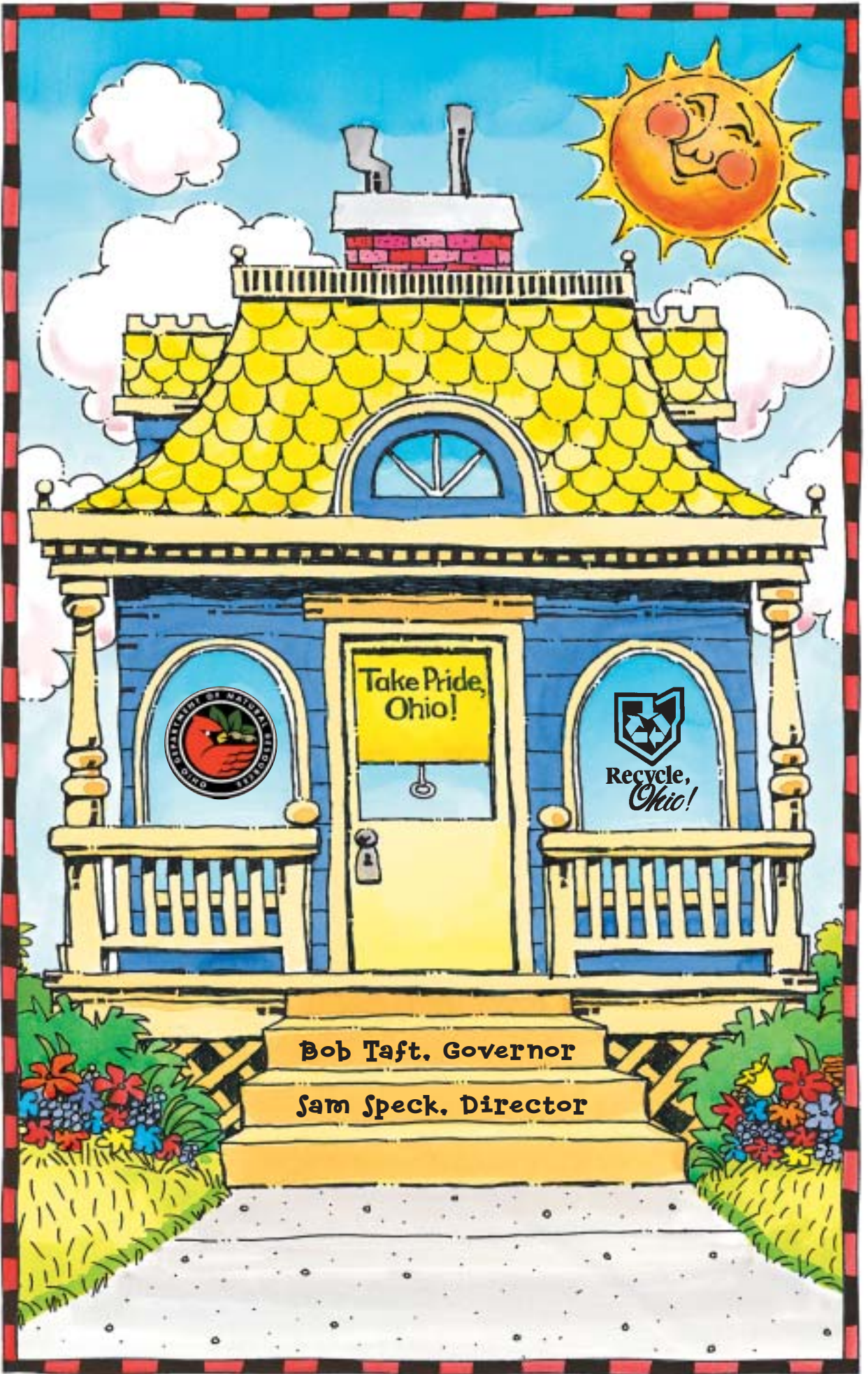
